
FIRE EXTINGUISHER PLACEMENT & LOCATION

Fire Extinguishers are required in many occupancies, however, on a national scale the NFPA mandates that all buildings other than family homes, duplexes, and manufactured homes must have a fire extinguisher.

Main factors for locating a Fire Extinguisher are Accessibility and Visibility





CLASS OF FIRE	TYPE OF FIRE	APPROVED FIRE EXTINGUISHER
Class A - Ordinary Combustibles	Wood, Paper, Cloth	Type A; Type A-B
Class B - Flammable Liquids	Gasoline, Paints, Oils, Grease	Type A-B; Type B-C; Type A-B-C
Class C – Live Electrical Equip.	Electrical wiring, Fuse box	Type B-C; Type A-B-C
Class D – Combustible Metals & Alloy	Magnesium, Sodium, Lithium Alloy	Sodium Chloride or Copper Formula
Class K - Commercial Cooking Equip.	Commercial Cooking Oil	Wet Chemical
